

FAQ's - Frequently Asked Questions

Minimum age to shoot here

There is no real age limit, old or young. The only limitation is physical ability on the part of the shooter. They have to be tall enough to shoot over the bench position and strong enough to support the firearm when fired and they have to deal with the recoil. Other than those there is really no limit and we encourage all age groups to shoot.

Physically Challenged Shooters

We have two shooting positions that have lower shooting bench positions as well as stools and chairs if needed to rest on. We also have additional shooting benches we can deploy at various heights. We have a very strong participation from those that have physical limitations and they find our facility very accommodating to meet their needs.

Single Shooters

This is the most difficult rule that most of local ranges follow. We do not allow unknown single shooters onto the range. Our Insurance requires that we allow those that we know are experienced shooters, member of the range for more than ten (10) days, Law Enforcement, Active Military, NRA Instructors, or individuals with Guard Cards, onto the range to shoot. There is no exception to this rule.

Rifles

All Rimfire (.17HMR, .22LR, etc..) rifles and pistol caliber (9mm, .357, .38spl, 45LC, etc..) rifles can be shot here without a rifle card. Please be prepared to show the rifle when checking in. Remember that a .223 is **NOT** a "22 rifle", it is a high powered rifle.

We do not allow just anyone to shoot their high powered rifles here at the range. The ability of a center fire rifle to cause severe damage to the range and perhaps others mandated an additional safety class just for rifles. This class is held each week on Sunday morning at 10:00 AM. We can hold a class during the week if there is enough interest from a small group. You can join the over 400 other rifle card holding members here at the range and shoot as much as you like.

Shotguns

As much as I would like to allow shotguns once again, it will not happen. We allowed it with the restriction that ONLY buckshot or slugs were allowed, and people decided to shoot regular birdshot as well. After some damage to the range and several shooters getting hit from "come-backs", we have banned all shotguns. The ONLY exception to this ban is for Law Enforcement training and our Personal Shotgun Defense Class. All shooting takes place directly in front of the backstop.
